1.0 SITUATION

- A very strong undersea earthquake of magnitude 8.0 has occurred at 4:39am this morning near 62km West-South-West of Kirakira, Makira Ulawa Province, Solomon Islands, (Latitude 10.7 degrees South and Longitude 161.4 degrees East).
- Shaking was strongly felt in Makira, South of Malaita, North of Guadalcanal and Renbel.
- Tsunami observed in Makira
- Tsunami Warning and Watch Advice initially issued at 4:39 am for Makira, Temotu, Malaita, Rennell & Bellona, Central Islands, South Guadalcanal Provinces issued this morning was cancelled at 9.30am.
- An ALL CLEAR was issued by NEOC at 10.25am

2.0 IMPACTS

Initial reports received from the Provinces indicated disaster impacts resulting from the earthquake and tsunami is presented in the summarised matrix below and Annex 1 and 2.




Figure1. Estimated affected population in Makira, Malaita and Temotu. Source, NDMO, 2016




Figure 2: Summary of affected infrastructures including houses. Source: NDMO, 2016
